WHAT TO DO IF YOUR CHILD IS HAVING A SEIZURE

Give diazepam if the seizure lasts over 5 minutes or if ____ seizures happen within ____ minutes

- 1 Stay calm and reassure your child.
- Make sure your child is in a safe place. If not, lay them down on the floor, or move furniture or sharp objects.
- 3 Start timing the seizure. Video the seizure if possible.
- At 4 minutes of seizure activity prepare the diazepam (Stesolid® tube).
- At 5 minutes of seizure activity, place your child in the recovery position and give diazepam into the bottom (rectally).
- Call 111 for an ambulance when you give the diazepam, unless instructed otherwise by your doctor.
- 7 Watch your child's breathing.
- 8 When the seizure has finished keep your child in the recovery position.

- 9 Let your child rest and recover in a calm and quiet space until back to normal.
- Record seizure in seizure diary.
